

RETURN TO PLAY PLAN

The Beaver Valley Curling Club has developed it's operating and safety plan in compliance with both Government Orders and guidelines provided by Curl B.C. and Curl Canada.

We have surveyed our club members and there is approximately 70% of our membership that have stated that they will return to play this season, if it can be done safely.

Our Goal is to provide a safe recreational environment for our members. The Guidelines we are providing are subject to change with ongoing COVID-19 requirements issued by the Provincial Health Officer.

SAFETY AND BEHAVIOUR

Personal Hygiene

- hand sanitation stations in rink
- hand washing in washrooms
- no handshakes
- Stay Home if you are sick

Any Symptoms do not come to Curling Rink

Building Cleaning

ON ICE

- more frequent cleaning of ice area
- prior to game one player to sanitize entrance/ exit door to your sheet
- prior to game one player to sanitize rocks (both sets on your sheet)
- during game only touch your own rocks
- only one player from game to conduct any measurement
- only one player from game to post any score
- no water jugs on ice

OFF ICE

WE RECOMMEND THAT FACE COVERINGS BE WORN IN LOCKER ROOM AND LOUNGE AREA

Many clubs have closed their locker rooms as they are congested

Ours is spread out much more and hopefully we can still use

Will add signage indicating traffic patterns and max numbers in areas

-Modified traffic patterns in building

-to and from locker room

-to and from ice sheets

-spacing in lounge area (4 person tables)

-change to vinyl chairs for cleaning

-stay in your team bubble

-plexiglass barriers to protect bar/ kitchen

BUILDING MOVEMENT (Traffic Patterns)

Main Entrance -stairs go down only

Back Entrance -stairs go down only

Stairs from basement up to BBQ Shack door (new lounge) -up only

ONTO ICE AREA

Sheets 1 and 2 use door to Sheet #1

Sheets 3 and 4 use door to Sheet #4

Curl BC has stated Curling is in Phase 3 of Startup for **Return to Play**

This means we can have teams with 3 or 4 players with Modified Sweeping

SWEEPING

Only one player can sweep. From Start to Stop

4th player stands on neutral dot

Skips can never sweep.

Skip calls the shot, calls for sweeping, and gets out of way as rock comes into house.

Opposing Skip cannot sweep.

PARTICIPATION WAIVER

All Players at Registration will be Required to sign a liability waver and PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

All participants of **BEAVER VALLEY CURLING CLUB** agree to abide by the following points when entering club facilities and/or participating in club activities under the COVID-19 Response and Return To Play (RTP) Protocol:

- I agree to symptom screening checks, and will let club know if I have experienced any symptoms in the last 14 days.
- I agree to stay home if I feel sick, and remain home for 14 days if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
- I agree to sanitize my hands upon entering and exiting the facility, with soap or sanitizer.
- I agree to sanitize the equipment I use throughout my practice with approved cleaning products provided by the club (shared and personal equipment).
- I agree to continue to follow social distancing protocols of staying at least 2m away from others.
- I agree to abide by all my club's COVID-19 policies and guidelines.
- I understand that if I do not abide by the aforementioned policies/guidelines that I may be asked to leave the club for up to 14 days to help protect myself and others around me.
- I acknowledge that continued abuse of the policies and/ or guidelines may result in suspension of my club membership temporarily.
- I acknowledge that there are risks associated with entering club facilities and/or participating in club activities, and that the measures taken by the club and participants, including those set out above and under the COVID-19 Response Plan and Return to Sport Protocols, will not entirely eliminate those risks.
